Cost of Production Study

Study Summary

The data analyzed for the presentation of the cost of production for apples in Nova Scotia was supplied by the Nova Scotia Fruit Growers Association and AgraPoint. The data supplied was surveyed 2007 financial data from 19 Nova Scotia farms. The 2007 data is presented as the actual and has been adjusted for inflation and expressed in 2010 dollars.

Of the 19 farms surveyed, 5 were representative of the small Nova Scotia apple producer with less than 30 acres. The medium sized producer is 30-80 acres and there were 5 farms surveyed at this size. The large farms for this study had greater than 80 acres and there were 9 farms in the study at this size.

The average cost to produce apples in Nova Scotia is calculated to be \$0.14/lb for 2010. The small and medium farms have a slightly higher cost to produce at \$0.15/lb and the larger farms on average are able to produce apples for slightly less \$0.13/lb.

There are two aspects of the 2007 costs that are not adequately accounted for when the costs are expressed in 2010 dollars these are the costs associated with on farm food safety and the labour costs.

At the time the data was collected, the surveyed farms did not have a cost for on farm food safety programs and therefore the costs for this are not incorporated in the 2010 figures. Additional work was done to determine an estimated cost for the on farm food safety as a cost per farm. This was done through the Nova Scotia Fruit Growers Association, growers and packers. On average the cost per farm for on farm food safety is between \$2,500 and \$3,000 annually. This additional cost for on farm food safety adds approximately \$0.29/bushel for the small producers, \$0.07/bushel for producers between 30 and 80 acres and \$0.04/bushel for large farms. The average additional cost based on all 19 farms is about \$0.06/bushel.

Since 2007 there has been a significant increase in minimum wage in Nova Scotia an increase of 27%. The increase in minimum wage results in an increased cost in hired labor of between \$0.26/bu and \$0.72/bu.

When the cost of production for 2010 is adjusted for the costs associated with on farm food safety and increases in minimum wage, the result is an average cost of production for apples in Nova Scotia of \$0.15/lb. The summary of these additions can be found at the end of each table on the following pages.
