There's a revolution in how clean, fresh, and local greens and herbs are being produced around the globe. Vertical farming is becoming a big player in growing these products, and GoodLeaf Farms is setting the bar high in terms of safety, quality and freshness.

Launched in 2015, GoodLeaf Farms has worked with its parent company, TruLeaf, to build its first farm in Truro, Nova Scotia. Using an extremely efficient indoor hydroponic system, GoodLeaf has turned Nova Scotia into a year-round producer of leafy greens, microgreens and herbs.

At GoodLeaf, we see Canada as an innovator and a world leader in leafy green production. By bringing production to major urban cities, we are localizing a product that normally travels from Southern US (over 2000 food miles) to reach our plates, losing taste and nutrition in the process.

Growing indoors also allows us to remove seasonality from our product lineup – we can grow with the same speed and high quality in January as we can in July.

We have a keen interest in creating the most efficient food production system possible. Our farm captures and stores rainwater - enough to supply the majority of the needs of the farm and offices. We also recycle nearly 90% of the water used on the farm, filter it, and then recirculate it back into the system.

GoodLeaf is currently expanding its farm network to Ontario with continued expansion plans across Canada.
