**Halifax Waterfront PARKING**

There are a number of simple and convenient ways to park on the waterfront.

**\$3 Hourly Rate**  
**\$16 Daily Flat Rate (8am–6pm)**  
**\$6 Overnight Flat Rate (6pm–8am)**  
HotSpot Parking also available.

Look for the **P** symbol on Lower Water Street.

Parking revenue is reinvested into the waterfront for family friendly events, maintenance and amenities.

Go up Sackville Street to Argyle St

Turn Right onto Argyle St

You will find the Halifax Convention Centre on your left
