PLANT HEALTH LAB



The Plant Health Lab complements the wine and grape services at Perennia by providing you with definitive, reliable and consistent results on grapevine viruses. Taking proactive steps to understand virus levels and

ensuring infected materials aren't used in grafting is important – not only for the health of your vineyard – but for the entire industry. Our team will conduct a systematic sampling procedure in a requested vineyard plot. We follow a specific protocol designed to provide the highest level of confidence in virus detection. Knowledge about virus status in your vineyard can help you make more informed management decisions. MOBILE BOTTLING UNIT



This is the first mobile bottling service located right here in Nova Scotia, and it offers flexible scheduling year-round. Using state-of-

the-art equipment, we can bottle up to 1,500 bottles an hour. We'll also apply your custom labels and seal it with natural or synthetic corks or screw caps. It's like having your own personal bottling plant without any capital investment in equipment or space.

RESEARCH UPDATE: TERROIR PROJECT

The overall goal of this initiative is to help Nova Scotia's winemaking industry become more efficient, competitive and profitable.
