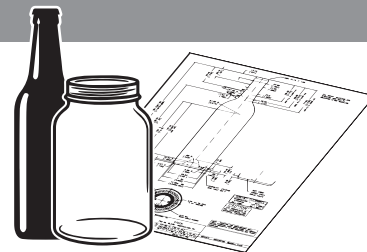


Dimensions

Material & Application Conditions



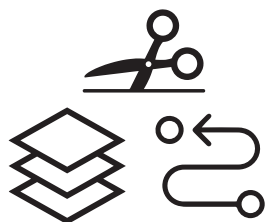

Printing Press

When order details and graphics have both been approved your order will be released into the production schedule. As a digital printer, we are not restricted to printing plates, meaning we can batch multiple flavours, colours, or produce variable information so no two labels are the same. This includes multiple sku printing to batch orders and keep cost per label down. Your order will soon be hot off the press!



Converting & Finishing



Printing is just one step of what MLP does. We offer embellishments such as metallic foil, embossing, and silk screening. Lastly, your printed labels go into the final steps of finishing. This involves protecting inks with varnishes or laminations, die cutting to the order specifications, and finally shipping or preparing for pickup at our Halifax location.

What's new at Maritime Labels & Packaging?

EMBELLISHMENT	DEFINITION
Hot Foil	Hot stamping or foil stamping is a method of relief printing in which we adhere metallic foil to label surface at high temperatures. There is a wide variety of colour options, however; Gold and Silver are stocked in-house and other colours are special orders. This embellishment requires ordering a custom stamping plate for each new design for an additional cost.
Embossing & Debossing	Embossing results in a raised surface with the design higher than the surrounding paper area. A similar but less common technique is Debossing which is where the design is lower than the surrounding areas. This embellishment can only be added on fibrous premium papers such as: Classic Crest, Estate and Felt materials. Embossing requires a custom pressing plate for each new design for an additional cost.
3D Embossing	Very similar to standard Embossing however, for 3D Embossing there are various levels to the design. This creates more depth and texture to the design. 3D Embossing requires a custom pressing plate for each new design for an additional cost.
Silk Screen	A stencil method of printmaking in which a design is imposed through a fine mesh, the ink is forced through the mesh onto the label surface. This embellishment can use various coloured inks including pearlescent and shimmering inks. This can be used to simply enhance your previously printed label. Silk Screen requires a custom screen for each new design for an additional cost.
Raised Silk Screen	Using the same screen method as standard silk screening, Raised Silk Screen uses a specific ink that is clear. This embellishment enhances the previously printed area with a high gloss texture, adding depth to your label. Raised Silk Screen requires a custom screen for each new design for an additional cost.
