

Companion Document to SFCR General Guide

All Other Foods

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DETERMINING WHAT IS APPLICABLE TO YOUR OPERATION

In order to determine which sections of the SFCR apply to your operation, we have streamlined the Timeline for All Other Foods (manufactured foods) from the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) website. This enables you to decide what applies to your situation, as the requirements are very specific to the activities conducted at your operation. For example, if your only activity is interprovincial trade, you would only require traceability; you would then proceed directly to the Traceability section in the general guide.

The definition of all other foods is any food that does not fall under the other SFCR timelines on the CFIA website (Dairy products, eggs, processed egg products and processed fruit or vegetable products, fish, meat products and food animals, fresh fruit or vegetables, honey and maple products, unprocessed food used as grain, oil, pulse, sugar or beverages as well as food additives and alcoholic beverages).
